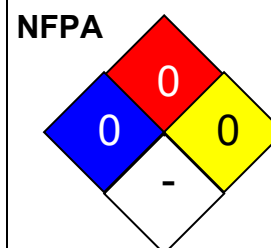
SECTION 4 -- FIRST-AID MEASURES
